All Classes

- 🇺🇸 Current negative Coggins required.
- 🇺🇸 NRHA Rule: Owner and Exhibitor must have current NRHA membership; Horse must have Horse Competition License.
- 🇺🇸 AQHA Rule: Exhibitor must have current AQHA card and AQHA Horse Registration papers.
- 🇺🇸 Only one judge fee for concurrent classes.
- 🇺🇸 Stall Fee: \$85 for entire show (2/1 – 2/5/12*)
***Note: those arriving Tuesday (1/31) will be charged an additional \$25 day stall fee**
- 🇺🇸 Day Stall/Grounds Fee: \$50 per day.
- 🇺🇸 Shavings: \$10.00 per bag (no outside shavings)
- 🇺🇸 Office Fee: \$25 per horse.
- 🇺🇸 Office fees *FREE* for youth class entries (horse ridden by youth only)
- 🇺🇸 Move-in Tuesday, January 31st at 12 noon
- 🇺🇸 RV Site Fee: \$25 per night

Green Rider Conditions

- 🇺🇸 NRHA rules apply for eligibility
- 🇺🇸 If you start the class one-handed, you must complete the class one-handed.
- 🇺🇸 If you start the class two-handed, you must complete the class two-handed.

TRHA \$1,000 Rider Conditions

- 🇺🇸 Limited to Non Pro Rider with less than \$1,000 in lifetime reining earnings prior to current show year.

2012 New Events

Non Pro Event

- 4 Classes: Non Pro, Novice Horse NP, 7-Up and Intermediate Horse
- 3 Divisions: NP, INP, LNP
- Awards for all divisions through 4th place.
- \$25 nomination fee per horse, rider combination per division.
- Must declare division at time of entry and all NRHA eligibility requirements apply.
- All NRHA entry and eligibility rules apply.
- Points kept only one rider, one horse combination. Can enter as many rider/horse combinations as desired and per NRHA Rules. Cannot combine points from one rider and multiple horses.
- May enter multiple divisions with the same rider/horse combination.
- Points kept of all 4 classes, must enter at least 3 of the classes per show.
- Point's totals will be combined from HOT Winter Slide and One HOT Reining for each rider/horse combination to determine the winner.
- One point for each rider with a score that you beat (0 and no scores don't count).
- NRHA tie breaker used to break ties.

Youth Event

- \$1,000 and \$500 scholarships to top 2 in 4 divisions.
- 4 Division System – Top score is #1 Division, -2.5 point is #2 Division, -5.0 point is #3 Division and -7.5 points is #4 Division.
- Example: Winner run is 74. This is #1D winner. Subtract 2.5 point from the highest score: 71.5. Rider with the closest score to 71.5 without going over is #2D winner. Subtract 5.0 point from the highest score: 69. Rider with the closest score to 69 without going over is #3D winner. Subtract 7.5 points from the highest score: 66.5. Rider with the closest score to 66.5 without going over is the #4D winner.
- If a tie between two riders occur than the tie will be broken by a flip of a coin. If a tie between 3 or more riders occurs than all riders names will go into a hat and 2 riders will be selected at random from all riders' names in the hat. The two names drawn will be declared the winner as follows: the first name drawn from the hat will be the \$1,000 winner and the second name drawn from the hat will be the \$500 winner.
- Rider must enter the NRHA 13 and under or NRHA 14-18 Reining at the HOT Winter Slide.
- Scores from both classes will be combined to determine the Youth Scholarship Winners.
- NRHA eligibility and competition rules apply.
- Some restrictions apply for distribution of scholarship funds. All restrictions must be met.
